

Senior Privilege – Final Exam Exemption

For the Class of 2012, we will continue the Senior Final Exam Exemption. The criteria will be as follows:

- 1) All Senior students enrolled in and taking an Advanced Placement (AP) exam will be exempt from taking a final exam.
- 2) Students who receive an 87 average for the first three terms and an 87 average for the fourth term, thru May 11, 2012 will be permitted to be exempted from the final exam. The 87 average for the first three terms will be computed using the first semester average (which includes the midyear exam) as 70% of the grade and the third term average as 30% of the grade. For second semester courses, students will use the 87 average for the third term and an 87 average for the fourth term, thru May 11, 2012.
- 3) Any student wishing to take a final exam even though they are exempt will be permitted to take an exam. Once a student decides to take the exam, the grade will be included in the final average.

Students will only be exempt when they are notified by their teacher. Students will be notified prior to the final exam week. If there is any question about exemption, students must confirm with the classroom teacher.
