

## LATE REGISTRATION

Medway Public Schools' late registration for the 2017-2018 school year for students who have not previously registered in the school system will be held on:

**August 22, 23, and 24, 2017, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

- **Pre-K, K and 1**, register at McGovern Elementary School, 9 Lovering Street.
  - To be eligible to enter kindergarten, a child must reach the age of 5 years on or before August 31, 2017.
- **Grades 2, 3, and 4**, register at the Burke/Memorial Elementary School, 16 Cassidy Lane.
- **Grades 5-8**, register at the Medway Middle School, 45 Holliston Street
  - Due to course selections, students in grades 5-8 should accompany their parents to registration.
- **Grades 9-12**, register at the High School, 88 Summer Street
  - Due to course selections, students in grades 9-12 should accompany their parents to registration.

Parents may call or come into the office to schedule an appointment with a counselor and are encouraged to pick up a new student registration packet at the main office in advance.

Parents registering children are required to bring the following:

- proof of residence
- birth certificate

- official health record (which must include a record of immunizations, lead poisoning screening and a recent physical examination)
- records from the previous school.

As mandated by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, all students entering grade 7 in September must have a current copy of a physician-signed physical examination dated within thirteen months. The examination form must also include the updated required following immunizations:

- Td or Tdap Tetanus Booster;
- documentation of chickenpox or Varicella Vaccine.

It is also recommended that children younger than 13 years old have a repeat Varicella Vaccine and that all students receive the Meningococcal Vaccine.
