Health & Safety

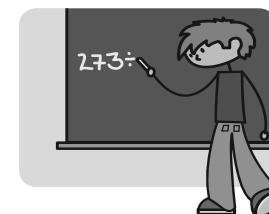
Your child's health, safety and well being are of primary concern to us. A health, medical and emergency form is required for each child. There is a registered nurse available at all times.

There is a low student-staff ratio allowing for a great deal of individual attention provided to each student. A Speech and Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapists, and a Physical Therapist work and/or consult directly with the students. The therapists also provide consultation to the program.

Description of Program

The Extended Year Program is provided for students with disabilities who require a longer school year to prevent substantial regression.

The EYP provides students with developmentally appropriate learning experiences that include: reading and language arts, mathematics, thematic units, arts and crafts, and physical activities. Other exciting learning activities are provided for students to experience and enjoy.

The EYP will provide daily social skills/pragmatic language groups to all students in grades Pre-K thru 8. Additionally, all students will participate in a weekly activity based OT.
