Policy # 57

Occupational Education

The Medway School Committee recognizes that students in kindergarten through grade 12 should:

1. Be afforded the opportunity to be informed about the world of work.
2. Be aware of the many vocations available to them.
3. Develop a respect for the dignity of work.
3. Be allowed the opportunity to develop an understanding regarding the technical, consumer, occupational, recreational, cultural aspects of industry and technology; they should also be afforded the opportunity to develop skills related to such aspects through creative problem-solving experiences.

The Medway School District belongs to the Tri-County Regional Vocational-Technical School, which will provide intensive vocational and technical education for students in grades 9-12 who enroll there.

The Medway School District also belongs to the Tri-County Partnership, a school-to-career system developed through the schools, local businesses and Chambers of Commerce
