School Committee Meeting
Budget Subcommittee
Minutes
November 18, 2020

The School Committee of the Medway Public Schools held a Budget Subcommittee meeting on Wednesday, November 18, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. in the Presentation Room at Medway Middle School, 45 Holliston Street, Medway, MA. School Committee members in attendance included Ms. Dietrich, and Ms. Sullivan. Also in attendance were Superintendent Armand Pires, Director of Finance Donald Aicardi and Assistant Business Manager Melissa Richard.

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, no in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted at this meeting.

A. CALL TO ORDER

- a. Ms. Dietrich called the meeting to order at 4:20 p.m.

B. DISCUSSION

- a. FY21 Budget Update
Dr. Pires explained that the update today would be covering expenses and revenue related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Aicardi gave an overview of the FY21 balances and discussed the revolving account balances as well. Mr. Aicardi informed the committee that earlier this week he learned that the amount the district will receive from the Town through the CARES Act has increased from \$650,00 to \$750,000. Mr. Aicardi explained a new line item is the renovation of the drop off lane at the Memorial School. Due to the increased vehicle traffic it was established that the drop off needs to be redesigned to ensure safety. Dr. Pires discussed the possibility of a one year extension of the Unit A contract. He plans on negotiating with the Food Service unit as well as the custodians.
